At the back of **Sacred Heart Basilica** there is a Roll of Honour for parishioners who died during War. There were 2 killed during the South Africa War; 34 during the Great War; and 28 during World War II.**3/2859 & 31821 Brigadier Patrick Augustine Ardagh CBE, DSO, MC, MID****Brig. P. A. Ardagh, D.S.O., M.C., of Christchurch, awarded the C.B.E.**

Born: 30 August 1891, Ngapara, second son of James & Elizabeth Ardagh; he attended Waitaki Boys' High School. Later the family lived at the Commercial Hotel, Timaru. He practiced medicine in Temuka before moving to Christchurch in 1914. He had a brother, Cyril, who was ordained to the priesthood in Sacred Heart Basilica during 1916.

He was a surgeon with the RNZ Medical Corps

Wife: Lily Ardagh who lived in Christchurch.

He initially enlisted in the army during WWI, on 13 January 1917, aged 25; he served with 2 NZ General Hospital, France. He was decorated with his DSO in WWI for gallantry and devotion to duty during an attack, October 1918, near Masnieers.

During WWII he served with the 2 NZ Division; 3 NZ

General Hospital & 1 Casualty Clearing Station.

He served in the Middle East & Italy.

Died: 6 April 1944 of sickness, aged 52.

Buried: Brookwood Military Cemetery, Surrey, England.

9952 Lance Corporal Francis Patrick Duffy

Son of Patrick & Annie (nee Moodie) Duffy of Fairview, Timaru.

Born: 6 October 1917; baptised at Sacred Heart on 4 November 1917 by Fr J Tubman.

He served with the NZ Army Service Corps, Supply Company. Died: in Crete, 25 May 1941, aged 23.

He has no known grave, but his name is on the Athens Memorial, Pharleroa War Cemetery, Athens, Greece.
