Parishioners can still drop off old notes & coins to redeem at the Reserve Bank in Wellington, I have \$250 in 5c coins waiting to go to the Reserve Bank; plus foreign coins that can be redeemed. Redundant coins are forwarded to the Lions for their Project.

So far over \$600 has been collected for the Earthquake Strengthening Campaign from 'dead money'.
